AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT
PURSUANT TO 18 U.S.C. § 2703

NOW COMES The State of Oklahoma, by and through Special Agent ADAM YORK, an Agent with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, and being duly sworn and upon Oath, states as follows:

Your Affiant is ADAM YORK, a duly qualified Special Agent for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI). Your affiant has approximately seven and a half years of law enforcement experience working for the Oklahoma Highway Patrol (OHP) and the OSBI. Your affiant's training and education include a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Central Oklahoma (UCO), a Master's Degree in Administrative Leadership (Government and Military) from the University of Oklahoma (OU), the 65th Oklahoma Highway Patrol Academy, the 16th Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation's Agents Academy, CLEET Advanced Peace Officer Certification, the Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) Course, the Traffic Homicide Investigations Course, the Reid Technique of Investigative Interviewing and Advanced Interrogation Course, US Army Anti-Terrorism Officer Basic Course, and the Texas Rangers' Public Integrity (Public Corruption) training. I, upon oath, depose and state as follows, to wit:

Your affiant, on behalf of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, respectfully applies to this Court for an Order requiring Verizon, located at 180 Washington Valley Road, Bedminster, New Jersey, to furnish to your affiant the following information concerning telephone number [REDACTED]

1. Provide any and all subscriber information for the above telephone number, including name, address, telephone number, inception of service, source of payment for service, and associated telephone numbers.
2. Provide information about the device to include: International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) and/or the make/model of the device.
3. Provide communication detail records to include: incoming and outgoing call detail records; incoming and outgoing SMS text detail records; MMS detail records; data records; internet web history; and internet protocol (IP) detail records, to include cell tower site/sector information between the dates of **August 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.**

4. Provide historical location information commonly referred to as LOCDBOR data, NELOS data, PCMD data, RTT data, TruCall, TDOA data, E9-1-1 records, and/or Timing Advance records between the dates of **August 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.**
5. Provide the remaining SMS or text message content, either incoming or outgoing, as well as any voicemails or voice messages between the dates of **August 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.**

Your affiant further requests this court to order Verizon to provide any technical assistance requested by your affiant or any other employee of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

In support of this warrant, your affiant respectfully submits to this Court as follows:


1. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as an agency of the State of Oklahoma, is a governmental entity pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2711 (4).
2. This Court is a court of competent jurisdiction to issue such orders as defined by Title 18 U.S.C. § 2711 and Section 3127 of the United States Code, and Title 13 Section 177.1 et seq. of the Oklahoma State Statutes.
3. As a court of competent jurisdiction, this Court has the authority to order the disclosure of the above information, pursuant to Title 18 U.S.C. § 2703 (b) and (c), and based upon the specific and articulable facts set forth below.

Further, in conformity with Title 18 U.S.C. § 2703 (d) of the United States Code, your affiant makes known to the court the following specific and articulable facts which indicate that the requested records and information are relevant and material to an ongoing criminal investigation.

PROBABLE CAUSE:

On August 30, 2024, Oklahoma State Department of Education Investigator BRAD DELOZIER informed the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office that an unknown person was sending letters with directives to various Oklahoma school districts in Oklahoma and impersonating an Elected Official, Oklahoma Superintendent of Public Instruction RYAN WALTERS.

On September 3, 2024, Oklahoma Attorney General GENTNER DRUMMOND requested full Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) investigative assistance into the false impersonation of WALTERS. The suspect in this investigation was unknown. OSBI Special Agent ADAM YORK was assigned as the case agent.

The letters were postmarked in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, on August 26, 2024, and were submitted to the OSBI Forensic Science Center (FSC) for analysis. On April 15, 2025, OSBI Latent Evidence Unit Senior Criminalist SHANA WILSON informed OSBI Special Agent ADAM YORK that fingerprints identified on a document from this investigation had a fingerprint that the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) systems identified as belonging to OWEN THOMAS CUNNINGHAM  of Wilmington, Massachusetts.

The letters were printed on the letterhead of the State of Oklahoma, featuring the state seal, and were signed "RYAN WALTERS" and dated August 26, 2024. On April 29, 2025, YORK interviewed WALTERS, who stated that he did not send the letters, sign them, or authorize anyone to send them on his behalf. WALTERS did not know CUNNINGHAM.

A License Plate Recognition (LPR) search of vehicles belonging to CUNNINGHAM identified his Dodge Ram pickup [REDACTED] as driving from Massachusetts to Oklahoma and being identified in Nichols Hills, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, on August 25, 2024, within 1.4 miles of a United States Post Office.


In October 2025, YORK contacted CUNNINGHAM'S family members and his Massachusetts Parole Officer, who all identified CUNNINGHAM'S phone number as [REDACTED]. YORK called and text messaged [REDACTED] and received a reply text message stating that the number belonged to CUNNINGHAM.

On November 3, 2025, YORK searched CUNNINGHAM'S phone number [REDACTED] in the Leads Online Toolbox, which identified the number as belonging to Verizon.

Your Affiant believes that probable cause exists that CUNNINGHAM committed the crimes of False Personation of Public Officers (Title 21, Chapter 61, Section 1533) and Forgery of State Seals (Title 21, Chapter 62, Section 1571), and that CUNNINGHAM'S cellphone data will further YORK'S ability to file charges against CUNNINGHAM.

Your Affiant also submits that the disclosure of this Affidavit or the Warrant will cause OWEN CUNNINGHAM, or anyone involved in this criminal investigation, to flee from prosecution, potentially, the destruction of or tampering with evidence, and would seriously jeopardize the above-described criminal investigation. Therefore, your Affiant requests that Verizon not disclose to the customer(s) or subscriber(s) the existence of this Order, or the affidavit for this Order, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2705 (c) (3).
