I, Detective Dakota Murley, the Affiant, being first duly sworn, upon oath, deposes and says:

The facts known to the Affiant, which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed and that the above-named person committed the offense, are the following:

On May 3, 2026, Edmond Patrol Officers responded to a mass shooting incident at the Scissortail Campgrounds at Arcadia Lake, 6400 E. 15th Street, Edmond, OK, Oklahoma County. Once officers arrived at the scene, they learned that a large party had occurred in one of the pavilion areas of the campgrounds. Attendees of the party included both juveniles and adults.

At approximately 8:51 PM, numerous rounds of gunfire were fired in rapid succession within the crowd of people. Numerous individuals were struck by the gunfire, and the party dispersed. Gunshot victims were subsequently transported to various hospitals around the Oklahoma City metro area. In total, approximately 23 individuals received injuries from the gunfire. The injuries ranged from minor to life-threatening.

Your Affiant responded to the scene to assist with the investigation. I spoke with several witnesses, then responded to Integris Baptist Hospital and obtained information from numerous victims. Throughout the investigation, several names were obtained as potential persons of interest who played a role in the gunfire. Witnesses and victims described the gunfire as automatic gunfire, possibly from a Glock with a "switch" attached.

Your Affiant knows, based on training and experience, that Glock handguns are commonly manufactured as semi-automatic pistols that discharge one round per trigger pull. Your Affiant further knows that an auto-sear conversion device, commonly referred to as a "switch," is designed to alter the function of a Glock handgun and allow it to discharge multiple rounds with a single continuous pull of the trigger. Accordingly, a Glock handgun equipped with an attached switch is capable of automatic gunfire, consistent with the information obtained from witnesses and victims.

Your Affiant also learned that a rifle had potentially been used during the shooting as well. During the investigation, numerous spent cartridge casings were located within the crime scene. The casings included both 9mm handgun and 7.62 caliber rifle ammunition.

[REDACTED] was identified as a person of interest involved in the shooting. On May 4, 2026, [REDACTED] was located and subsequently detained during a traffic stop. [REDACTED] spoke with your Affiant and other investigators, and named Jaylan Amhad Davis as the primary aggressor during the shooting. [REDACTED] also claimed that [REDACTED] called him shortly after the shooting. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he had been shot, and "3zzy," Jaylan Davis, was the shooter. [REDACTED] had been shot in the back and briefly spoke with investigators during the investigation.

[REDACTED] knew "3zzy" to be a member of North Highland Piru and advised that he recently got into a fight with [REDACTED] a known member of Hoover. [REDACTED] advised that this fight caused havoc between Jaylan and the Hoover gang members in Oklahoma City. [REDACTED] reiterated that [REDACTED] informed him that "3zzy" arrived at the party and started shooting.

Additionally, throughout the investigation, numerous agencies within Oklahoma City had received several anonymous tips regarding the shooting. Jaylan Davis had been named as one of the shooters in some of those anonymous tips.

Jaylan Davis has a lengthy criminal history, which includes numerous felony convictions, including robbery, firearms possession, and gang-related offenses. Jaylan was adjudicated as a Youthful Offender in Oklahoma County.

On May 4, 2026, a search warrant for Jaylan's Oklahoma City residence was granted by an Oklahoma District Court Judge and subsequently executed. Jaylan was not home at the time of the warrant service. However, during the search, a rifle light, .40, and 7.62 caliber ammunition were located within the residence. The brand of 7.62 ammunition matched the same brand of ammunition of several of the 7.62 spent cartridge casings that had been recovered at the crime scene.

Additionally, Jaylan's mother was present during the warrant service and informed me that she had last seen Jaylan on Sunday evening around 5 PM. He had left to attend a party at Lake Hefner with two of his friends. He was wearing a blue jacket, jeans, and white-and-blue Jordan shoes. White and blue Jordan shoes were observed in Jaylan's room during the warrant service. Jaylan also posted a picture on his Instagram on Sunday, wearing the same clothing and shoes that his mother had described. Jaylan's mother also received a text message around 10:30 PM Sunday night, which stated that she needed to check on Jaylan because he was present at the Arcadia Lake party during the mass shooting incident. Jaylan's mother had not spoken to him since he left Sunday evening and had been unable to contact him.


Based on the totality of the facts and circumstances developed during this investigation, your Affiant believes probable cause exists to show that Jaylan Amhad Davis was present during the mass shooting incident and used a firearm to commit assault and battery upon others by means likely to produce death.

Based on the facts and circumstances set forth above, and pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute 22 O.S. § 171, your Affiant believes probable cause exists to show that the offense(s) described herein were committed and that **Jaylan Amhad Davis** committed said offense(s). Your Affiant respectfully requests that this Court issue a warrant for the arrest of **Jaylan Amhad Davis** for the criminal charge(s) of:

1. 1 ct. – Assault and Battery with a Deadly Weapon 21 O.S. § 652(C)
