PC Narrative

On listed date / time, I (Ofc J Fulton TPD) was radio assigned to Lt Oxford for an assist, as he had a large crowd forming disrupting his ability to conduct an investigation, in the area of 200 N Maybelle Ave. Lt. Oxford and two other officers were already dealing with a large crowd assembly and already could not contain the scene that was going on. A suspect later identified as Robert Miller was recording the officers with his phone. While recording on his phone, Miller started to walk towards Lt. Oxford while he was talking to the arrested subject and the other detainees. Lt. Oxford asked Miller to stay back 25 feet. Miller stated "is this 25 feet?" Lt. Oxford stated yes that's fine just stay there. While Miller was standing their recording, Miller kept interjecting himself by distracting Lt. Oxford by talking loudly towards Lt. Oxford. Thus distracting Lt. Oxford from performing his duties and investigation. Miller also kept getting closer while talking loudly. Lt Oxford, told Miller to step back again. Miller stepped back and continued talking loudly towards Lt. Oxford still distracting Lt. Oxford. Lt. Oxford told him to step back another time, and Miller repeated this one more time. When more officers arrived, Lt. Oxford told Officer Marshall to arrest Miller. When Officer Marshall approached Miller, Miller walked away when any reasonable person would have known he was being detained.

This was a large chaotic scene with multiple Officers having to respond and it took some time for Officers to solve the entire investigation. This was made much more difficult by Miller impeding Officer actions and taking police resources away from the problem at hand.

Listed events occurred in City / County of Tulsa and were recorded on multiple department-issued BWC. We were wearing TPD issued Class B patrol uniforms with POLICE and a badge clearly visible, and driving marked TPD issued patrol vehicles with POLICE and a badge clearly visible.
